Summary of By-Law Changes and/or Additions

These changes reflect the vote of the Board of Governors and the specific wording complies with the intent of the Board as approved by the Executive Committee. Ratification of these amendments by the full membership will be sought at the 1983 CALLERLAB Convention in Philadelphia. All changes in your copy of the By-Laws have been annotated with vertical lines to indicate the change.

Article II, Section 7. Additional Continuing Requirements for Membership: The following sentence has been added "Any member who has been a member in good standing for a consecutive period of eight (8) years will be exempt from the Actively Calling requirement in order to maintain full membership." This was approved to take advantage of the years of experience and leadership of callers who have reduced their calling to fewer than fifty (50) dances per year.

Article II, Section 9. Gold Card Membership: This is an additional membership category and is intended to enable CALLERLAB to avail itself of the expertise of those who for one reason or another are no longer presently calling. The Gold Card Award was first awarded in 1978 and we did not have a wording within the By-Laws. This wording parallels the words inscribed on the "Gold Card".

Article III, Section 6f and 6g. Both of these were added to clarify the duties of the Board of Governors with regard to the Executive Committee.

Article IV, Section 1. Executive Committee: In the first paragraph, the following has been added: "The Board of Governors shall elect one member of the Executive Committee to serve as Chairman of the Board of Governors and who shall also serve as Chairman of the Executive Committee and the annual meeting of members to be held a year hence. The Board of Governors shall also elect one member of the Executive Committee to serve as Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee and the annual meetings of members to be held a year hence. The Executive Secretary and Assistant Executive Secretary shall also serve on the Executive Committee but shall do so in a non-voting capacity." This change was made to provide for continuity in the event of unforeseen developments that might affect the ability of the Chairman to fulfill his duties.

Article IV, Section 3a and 3b. The Vice Chairman of the Executive Committee: Sections 3a and 3b are additions to the By-Laws to legally establish the office of Vice-Chairman.

All of the above changes and/or additions have been reviewed by legal counsel to insure that they are proper and correct.

***** S T A R T *****

For the Quarter beginning January 1, 1983, the Mainstream Quarterly Selections Committee has selected one new move for workshops at Mainstream dances. Please note that not all groups want new material and not all groups desire the moves from other than standard positioning. The move selected is **DIVIDE TO A COLUMN**. The definition and some dancing examples follow:

Definition: **DIVIDE TO A COLUMN**.

Starting formation - $\frac{1}{4}$ Tag formation (Wave between facing couples)

Outsides Divide and Touch $\frac{1}{4}$ - Wave ends and adjacent centers Cast off $\frac{3}{4}$.

Move ends in right hand columns. Timing is 6 beats based upon the timing for Cast-Off $\frac{3}{4}$. The Divide and Touch $\frac{1}{4}$ can also be accomplished in this same time.

Dancing Examples:

From Static Square

Heads Pass the Ocean, DIVIDE TO A COLUMN,
Single File Circulate, Boys Run,
Pass Thru, Trade By, Star Thru,
Cross Trail Thru, Allemande Left.

Four Ladies Chain, Heads Pass the Ocean,
DIVIDE TO A COLUMN, Single File Circulate,
Boys Run, Square Thru $\frac{3}{4}$, Allemande Left.

Heads Square Thru, Pass to the Center,
Centers Touch, DIVIDE TO A COLUMN,
Single File Circulate Boys Run, Touch,
Everybody Fold, Right and Left Grand.

PREFERENCE INDICATIONS FOR THE QUARTERLY SELECTIONS - 1983

Each year prior to the convention, we offer the CALLERLAB membership an opportunity to express their preferences on which moves should be retained on the Mainstream QS list, which should be dropped or which should be recommended to the Mainstream Committee for consideration of additions to the MS list. The rules for eligibility to be added to the Mainstream list are as follows:

1. That a move must have been on the QS list for a period of not less than three years.
2. The recommendation to be added is not automatic.
3. The MS Committee does not have to add a call just because it has been recommended by the QS Committee
4. No more than three (3) calls can be added and no more than three (3) calls can be deleted from the Mainstream list during any single year. (The resolution passed in 1981 permits additions to the Mainstream list but no deletions.)

Since a call may be retained, dropped or moved to the MS list, we would appreciate it if you would make only one entry per line. In other words, if you would like to move a call to the MS list but if it does not get moved you would like it retained on the QS list, place a check mark in Column Three - "KEEP IF NOT SELECTED FOR MS". If, on the other hand, you want a move to stay on the list and not move to MS, even if eligible, then vote for that move under Column One - "KEEP".

Calls eligible to be moved to the MS list are marked with a **.

This means there is only one call eligible to be added. We do not have to add any to the MS list. Our resolutions provide that we do not have more than 10 on the QS list at the start of a new year. Since there are only six calls or figures on the list at this time, we do not have to drop any either. The list could remain as is; it could have some dropped because of limited dancer appeal or we could recommend that DIXIE DERBY be added to the MS list.

Please give this list your serious consideration. However, keep the dancer in mind when you make your preference vote. It is the dancer who pays the tab and we are dealing with the QS list which is for the MAINSTREAM DANCER (one who dances approximately once a week or less). You may also make any comments along side of Column Three so that we can consider your views.
