Flip. received the CALLERLAB Milestone award in 1981. As a .Founding Member. of CALLERLAB, Flippo has contributed to the suc-cess of CALLERLAB in many ways. He has served on CALLERLAB's Board of Governors and has been an icon, as well as an ambassador of CALLERLAB since its inception. His pres-ence alone makes CALLERLAB a better organi-zation.
